Fair Share

- "network fees", "fair share", "sending party network pays"...
- The age-old question: to compel content providers to pay the companies that provide network infrastructure to end users?
 - ...now with a new spin: "US Big Tech companies to pay EU telcos"
- Charged atmosphere between the Commission/European telcos (and their industry association, ETNO) and many in the Internet industry and technical community

The "fair share" debate: a tale of lobbying, capture and hypocrisy!

 In June, the Parliament passed a resolution calling for measures to ensure "a fair contribution from Large Traffic Generators (LTGs)"

NIS 2

- Update to the 2016 Network and Information Systems (NIS) Directive
- Directive in effect from January 2023 (Member States have 21 months to transpose to national law)
- Some early focus on efforts to include "European root server operators" in scope of the law
 - Coordinated community engagement with the different institutions ensured this was not included in the final text
- Requirements on other actors, including ccTLDs (Article 28), regarding accuracy of data; but concern that different states will implement different rules

e-Evidence

- A package (including a Regulation and a Directive) designed to, "make it easier and faster for police and judicial authorities to access the electronic evidence they need in investigations"
 - Elements came into force in August (the Regulation will come into force from August 2026)
- Significantly, legal orders for electronic evidence can be made from law enforcement to operators in other EU jurisdictions (without having to go via the local courts)
- Originally proposed in 2018 (five years of negotiation)



Cyber Resilience Act

• "... introduces mandatory cybersecurity requirements for hardware and software products, throughout their whole lifecycle"

- While the European Commission notes, "specified exclusions such as opensource software", there has been significant concern in the open source community
- A public consultation was held at the beginning of the year; current draft approved by parliamentary committee in July



DSA/DMA

Digital Services Act

- Proposed 2020, passed November 2022
- This April, the European Commission designated 19 platforms and 3 search engines as "Very Large Online Platforms" (VLOSEs)

Digital Markets Act

 Passed in November 2022, in force since May 2023



- European Commission has now identified six gatekeepers and 22 core platform services (operated by those gatekeepers)
- Gatekeepers must abide by "do's and don'ts" in how they manage their customer relationships

Al Act

- Artificial intelligence a hot topic in the last 18 months
- EU effort is just one of many, including Council of Europe work on a <u>convention</u>, and UN Security Council <u>discussions</u>, and various national regulations
- Al Act described as, "the world's first comprehensive Al law"
- Parliament adopted a position in June, but with significant changes to original draft





DNS4EU

- Announced as part of the 'EU's Cybersecurity Strategy for the Digital Decade' in 2020, DNS4EU is a public DNS resolver established in Europe and funded (initially) by the EU
- A tender process in 2022 selected Whalebone, a consortium based in CZ, to develop the service
- From a recent Whalebone presentation:

"The EU desires to make this the officially recommended DNS resolver for public and governmental institutions"




